### Suggested sowing rates

**Marginal dryland:** 3 – 5 kg/ha

**Good dryland:** 8 – 10 kg/ha

**Irrigated:** 15 – 25 kg/ha

### Product fit

Anyone seeking a highly palatable sweet forage that will not run to head quickly. Hunnigreen will stay leafier longer than some competitor varieties and lessen your risk of ergot.

### Key features

- Sweet sorghum x sweet sorghum
- Excellent standover feed for late grazing into autumn and winter
- Late flowering reduces ergot risk
- Suitable for grazing and some hay making situations
- Excellent for silage
- Leafy with excellent palatability
- Can be grazed all summer

Hunnigreen is a superior quality forage sorghum that will not flower until day length is less than 12 hours and 20 minutes. This means it will remain in the vegetative stage and still produce large amounts of quality leaf, when other quicker flowering sweet sorghums have started to run to head.

Hunnigreen is higher quality, sweet grazing for longer production.
